Dear Parents/Guardian,

On behalf of MK Dons Netball Club I would like to welcome your child to the club and provide you with some information about our activities. The club provides opportunities for young people between Y7 and Y13 to receive netball coaching in a training session and to attend competitions whenever possible. All coaching is by qualified, or training to be qualified coaches, who have been screened for their suitability for working with young people.

#### **Training Sessions**

Training sessions are weekly but timings and venues vary for age groups dependent on coaching staff and venue availability and details will be posted on the club website. Any closure dates (such as use of school premises for exams etc) will be notified in advance wherever possible.

The club work closely with MK Netters Junior Netball club and provide as many local girls as possible access to as high a standard of netball that we can. The regional teams for both MK Netters and MK Dons Set train separately to the MK Netters club training, to enable girls to progress and enjoy netball at their appropriate level.

#### **Payment Details**

The club has a small annual membership fee of £20.00 / player. The membership fee should be paid as soon as possible please preferably by 1st September.

Membership subs contribute to the ongoing costs of running the club. The subs are £17 /child payable by standing order on 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, please use the following details for online banking.

If you wish to discuss your payments please do not hesitate to speak to your session Coach / Team Manager. It is important to note that the standing order is based on 12 equal monthly payments and payments continue during the school holidays even when there are no training sessions planned. The club will be operating a strict NO PAY / NO PLAY policy from September as the running costs are so tight we need to ensure ALL subs are paid on time.

#### **Travel Arrangements**

Arrangements should be made for your child to travel to and from training sessions and matches unless other arrangements have been made. We would appreciate it if children can *arrive promptly* and are *collected promptly* at the end of the session. If in an emergency you will be late collecting your child please ensure the Coach / Team Manager are aware. YOU MUST COLLECT YOUR CHILD FROM THE HALL – DO NOT WAIT IN THE CAR PLEASE

Please note that the club is not responsible for any child arriving early for a session or after the sessions have ended. The club is also not responsible for any child that is not registered with the club.

#### **Personal Details**

We would be grateful if you could complete all the attached club forms as soon as possible. For the safety of your child it is important that the club is informed of any medical condition or allergies that may be relevant should your child fall ill or be involved in an accident while at the club. Please also inform us of any change in your personal details e.g. contact numbers, address as soon as possible.

Please note we require a contact number for someone who is contactable while your child is attending the club sessions.

### **Support MK Dons Set**

The club is always looking for people to assist with the running of the club as it eases the workload of other volunteers. If you would like to offer some help to the club in ANY way; coaching, umpiring, team management or committee involvement then speak to one of the club officials.

# **Code of Conduct for Players:**

Netball Sport ethic: Respect, Teamwork, Achievement and Fun

By abiding by these Codes of Conduct, netball players can achieve respect, good sportsmanship, high standards of behaviour and ethics to provide them with an enjoyable, safe and stimulating experience.

Everyone must conduct themselves in an honest, fair, impartial and transparent manner.

1		will	Respect:

- 1. The rules, regulations and requirements of the Sport, including, but not limited to, any competitions in which I participate either directly or indirectly
- 2. The rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in netball, regardless of gender, marital status, race, colour, disability, sexuality, age, occupation, religion or political opinion
- 3. The rights, dignity and worth of Children, Young People and Adults at Risk and ensure that I am aware of the Safeguarding best practice guidelines and procedures when interacting with them.
- Confidentiality and the sensitivities of information I hold on other individuals.
- 5. Netball and the individual's reputation and not take any action or make inappropriate comments about a fellow participant, coach, official, volunteer or member of England Netball's staff that will bring the Sport or those associated with delivering the Sport into disrepute, including making comments on social media technology. I will respect EN's guidance and policies on social media technology.
- The position I hold within Netball and always conduct and dress myself in an appropriate manner.
- 7. The result of the game and will not attempt to offer, offer or accept either directly or indirectly any consideration whatsoever in return for influencing or attempting to influence the result or seek to achieve personal gain on a result which I can influence by betting on any match or event where I am participating, either by playing, coaching or officiating, or through direct or indirect involvement.

### Netball is based on Teamwork, therefore I will:

- 8. Not abuse or misuse any relationship of trust or position of power or influence held by me in my team, be that my playing team, Club, County, Regional or England Netball
- Be on time, dressed appropriately and ready to give my full attention to the role I am carrying out within Netball
- Recognise that individuals bring different qualities and attributes but "together we will excel".
- 11. Welcome new members, volunteers, and connected participation and cooperate with Members, Connected Participants, colleagues, coaches, officials and administrators already in the Sport.

### I recognise individuals participate in Netball to achieve and have fun, therefore I will:

- 12. Recognise the achievements of others and applaud their successes
- 13. Endeavour to ensure that all involved in the Sport optimise their potential by promoting the positive aspects of the sport and never condoning the use of inappropriate or abusive language, inappropriate relationships, bullying, harassment, discrimination or physical violence.
- 14. Not impinge on others enjoyment of the Sport or my performance by consuming alcoholic drinks or smoke immediately prior to or while participating in the sport, or while safeguarding children, young people or vulnerable adults

- 15. Ensure that everyone has the opportunity to participant in a fair, honest environment by rejecting cheating, abiding by the Anti-Doping policies and not taking illegal substances immediately prior to or while participating in the Sport.
- 16. Display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat; be sporting whether I win or lose; always acknowledge the other team and the umpires at the end of the game with a hand shake or three cheers.
- 17. Never argue with an official or participant during a game and listen to and cooperate with officials' decisions
- 18. Control my temper; I understand that verbal, emotional and physical abuse of officials, coaches, spectators or participants, or deliberately distracting or provoking a participant, coach or official is not acceptable or permitted behaviour in netball
- 19. Enjoy the game and ensure others can also enjoy it.

# Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers:

At MK Dons Set the enjoyment and safety of your child when involved in a netball activity is of paramount importance. Every child will be encouraged and asked to ensure that their behaviour and actions meet the values and standards expected of them at all times. As parents, you are asked to support our Codes of Conduct and embrace the spirit of our game.

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Everyone must conduct themselves in an honest, fair, impartial and transpare

#### Parent / Carer's name

- 1. Encourage my child to play within the rules and respect officials' and coaches' decisions.
- 2. Support my child's efforts and performance, give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort and learning.
- Understand that competition is about winning and losing, so results are always accepted without undue disappointment.
- 4. Be a positive role model to my child by helping them work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship.
- 5. Remember that children learn best by example; I will applaud good play by both my child's team and their opponents.
- Thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who give their time for my child and not interfere with their decisions.
- 7. Help when asked by a coach or official.
- 8. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of gender, marital status, race, colour, disability, sexuality, age, occupation, religion or political opinion.
- 9. Read the rules of the sport to understand better what I am watching and discussing with my child.
- 10. Promote this code of conduct to other parents, carers and supporters.
- 11. Be aware of my child's club safeguarding policy and ensure that any concerns are reported to the club's safeguarding officer of England Netball's Lead Safeguarding Officer.

#### As a parent / carer, I will not:

- 12. Pressure my child in any way; I know that this is their sport not mine.
- 13. Use inappropriate language, harass athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators.
- 14. Criticise or ridicule my child for making a mistake or losing after the game.
- 15. Force my child if they are unwilling to participate in the sport
- Arrive at a netball activity under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- 17. Use Social Media technology to bring the game into disrepute or make an inappropriate comment about an athlete, coach, official, volunteer or member of England Netball staff.
